## Effective for students entering Fall 2011

You must successfully complete courses/experiences for credit to cover all of the K-State 8 areas. If you plan well this **should not** add additional hours to the 127 credits required for the Ag Econ/Agbus degree. When a course is tagged for two areas, you **may count that course toward both requirements**. (A course can only be used twice.) You must have a **minimum of four course prefixes** (AGEC) from different departments. Equivalent transfer classes will satisfy the K-State 8 requirements. The courses listed are some of the most common ways for you to meet the requirements.
